Antihistamines and hydrocortisone presumably penetrate the epidermis and exert antihistaminic and anti-inflammatory effects in the upper dermis. Their mechanism of action is discussed in Chapter 11. Systemic absorption of hydrocortisone from shampoo formulations used twice-weekly for 6 weeks has been shown to be clinically insignificant.

However, side effects remain one of the problems for long-term use; thus, there is a need for anti-inflammatory drugs with less severe side effects. In addition, recent interest in alternative treatments for arthritis [4 , 5] has promoted their use in the US, but scientific evidence of antiarthritic efficacy is lacking.
